

Installing a gas fireplace in your home

If anything can enhance the heating efficiency of your room considerably, it is the fireplace with gas fires. The best part of it is that the decor of your home remains intact. It also does not ruin your remodeling plans. In the past a masonry chimney was required with each new fireplace. This meant breaking of the roof and the wall and raising the chimney to height above the roof. The modern fireplace can be installed with a single vent in the wall that would help ventilation.

Calculating the efficiency of your fireplace

You will require your fireplace to be efficient. Whether it is a gas fireplace or using electric fires you should have some effective means to judge the efficiency of the fireplace you have installed. Like many other such home appliances the fireplace also has a British thermal unit or Btu efficiency rating process that calculates the heat generated by the fireplace.

Another indicator of the efficiency of the fireplace is the Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency rating or AFUE rating. The process has a lot of similarity with the determination of mileage to find out the fuel consumptions by a car. The AFUE process figures out the use of energy components in the cycles of heat generation till it reach the target temperature. You should use the numbers from the same scale while rating the efficiency of your fireplace. Ordinarily the steady state rating registers higher results compared to the AFUE ratings.

Fireplace types

There are three types of fireplaces that are in use to day. You have the option to choose among them basing on your requirements and budget while installing a gas fireplace. The criteria for determining your selection of models are the space available and the type of your residence.

Inserts, Direct-Vent, and also the Vent-free models are the three we are speaking of about fireplaces. A unique feature is that most of the gas fireplaces could be converted so that you can use propane. Similarly most of the wood using models could also have gas jets added to them so that that heating capabilities are boosted adequately.

Convenience of use, ease and comfort

Gone are the days when people used cumbersome, junky, and complicated items to have their household works performed. Today most of the customers are looking for ease and convenience of use that would make them comfortable with the use of the object in question. In case of fireplaces also people would like to have such fireplaces that would occupy less space, would be easy to use, and give you and your house a comfortable feeling.
